HCBC: Membership to HCBC is required of both rider and horse owner. Please include photocopy with entry. HCBC rules to apply.

Entries: Close August 2 (Friday) at 5pm. Entries may be dropped off in person, mailed, or scanned and sent via email. Entries must include all required information and payment.

Ride Times: Ride times will be available on Thursday (August 8th) PM. Once ride times are posted they are final. Those who request a time change after posting will be at discretion of Show Manager and will be charged \$10.00 + GST change fee.

Late Entries/ Substitutions: May be accepted at the discretion of the Show Office with a late fee of \$10.00 +GST. Substitutions may be accepted with 48 hrs notice to start of show.

Forms/Payment No refunds after closing date.

Lunging: Lunging is permitted in the round pen provided only.

Competitor/ Equine Wear: Allowed: boots and bandages. Headgear and proper boots must be worn, neat attire expected. Helmets must always be worn while riding on property. Competitors are not permitted to wear headsets.

Freestyle Music: Music needs to be on MP3 device i.e. ipod and have Bluetooth capabilities. Rider must organize for someone to play music for them. Please contact the Show Office with any questions regarding music material.

Show Office/ Facility Access: The Show Office will be open 30 minutes before the start of the first class. The facility gates will open to competitors and spectators 2 hours prior to first ride time on show days.

Haul In /Warm Up Day: The arena's will be made available on Friday August 9th after 2pm for warm up day. Each haul in ride for warm up day is \$25.00/ride and must be completed on the entry form. Riders are to check in at the Show Office to collect entry number; which must be displayed on horse/rider during warm up ride.

Food/ Beverage: The High Point Café will be open for complimentary coffee and pastries each morning. Lunch will not be provided.

Dogs: Well behaved, leashed dogs (who leave no evidence) are welcome.



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Trailer Parking: Trailer Parking is available in the field adjacent to High Point Equestrian Centre. Trailers may not park on the side between the indoor and outdoor arena, except to unload quickly.

Stabling: Day stalls are available at \$30.00 + GST, per day with a clean out deposit of \$30.00. Overnight stalls are available at \$70.00 + GST/night. All stalls will be assigned by stall sign or chart. Overnight stalls must be COMPLETELY STRIPPED of all hay, shavings & manure, if stall is not completely bare the deposit will be cashed or charged to card on file. Day stalls must be cleaned of all manure, urine, and hay. Stall does not need to be completely stripped.

AN AWARDS PRESENTATION WILL TAKE PLACE AFTER THE SHOW ON SUNDAY. YOU MUST BE PRESENT TO RECEIVE YOUR AWARD; WITH OR WITHOUT YOUR HORSE.
