RULES AND POLICIES

General

High Point Equestrian Center's (the "Club") vision is to provide a safe and enjoyable environment to all using its facility as well as promote a spirit of co-operation and respect. These rules and guidelines apply to everyone on Club premises including members, guests, visitors, and staff. These policies are the standard on which good stable practices are based and are to be adhered to at all times. They are subject to revision by the Board of Directors as deemed necessary and will be reviewed annually.

NOTE: The High Point rules have been numbered and bullets have been used to refer to the Club guidelines.

Hours of Operation

The Equestrian Center barns and turnout paddocks are open daily from **0800 to 2200**.

The riding rings are open until **2100**.

The lounge, fitness facility and tennis court are open from **0600 to 2300**.

Members are permitted to use the facility only during the stated hours unless otherwise arranged with the General Manager.

The office is open Monday to Friday **1000 to 1800**, to ensure assistance please contact the office to set up meeting.

Special operating hours will be posted in the barns for Christmas, New Year's and all statutory holidays.

Membership Definitions

Boarders are social members who keep their horses at High Point and shall enjoy unlimited access to and the use of the following amenities:

- The full use of the equestrian facilities including tack lockers and industrial laundry facilities
- Concierge Service available for an additional cost
- Priority booking to attend shows, clinics, and seminars
- The High Point lounge, patio and BBQ area
- The tennis court and fitness center

Enhanced members are social members who pay an additional monthly fee for the limited use of the equestrian facilities. There will be no more than 10 such memberships issued in a year. Enhanced members shall enjoy unlimited access to and the use of the following amenities:

- The High Point lounge, patio and BBQ area
- The tennis court and fitness center

have limited access to:

- Guest Paddock
- Indoor, outdoor arena , and round pen

Social Members are members who pay a monthly fee for use of the clubhouse facilities and equestrian event/show privileges. Members shall enjoy access to and the use of the following amenities:

- The High Point lounge (for Clubhouse extended memberships)
- The patio and BBQ area (for Clubhouse extended memberships)
- The tennis court and fitness center

Guest Policy

Members' guests are welcome to ride at High Point under the following rules:

1. Members will be responsible for the conduct of guests introduced by them and for all their indebtedness to the Club. All guests must abide by the Rules of the High Point Riding Association.
2. Guests of a member with riding privileges may enjoy the privileges of the lounge, tennis court and fitness center, provided they sign an Acknowledgment of Risk and Release of Liability form and the sponsoring member is on the premises.
3. A guest fee for the gym or tennis courts is \$10.00 per guest, per visit. Members MUST sign their guest in on the guest sign-up sheet located in the gym. Member must also ensure their Guest sign a waiver. Guests are not permitted to be in the fitness centre or tennis courts without signing a waiver.
4. Guest invitations shall not be extended to the same person more than once per calendar month.
5. Exception: Special consideration may be given to guests staying long term at a member's home. A request for special guest privileges must be submitted to the General Manager for approval.
6. **Visiting guest** who attended special events held at the High Point Equestrian Center will be expected to follow the rules of the High Point Equestrian Club

Attire

1. Muddy footwear, footwear capable of marring floor surfaces, and spurs must not be worn in the Clubhouse, tennis court, and fitness centre.

Children

1. Children 12 years of age and younger, including members, guests, visitors, or spectators, should be kept under close supervision. Children and youth under the age of 18 are not permitted in the Clubhouse Lounge unsupervised.

Dogs

1. Dogs on High Point property must be on a leash at all times and a staff or member may ask the owner/handler to remove the animal from the premises if it becomes disruptive to horses, riders, and others.
2. Dogs are not allowed into the Clubhouse, tennis court, fitness area, and the riding arenas.
3. Owners/handlers are responsible to pick up after their dogs

Alcohol Use at the High Point Equestrian Center and Clubhouse

1. Only persons of legal age are permitted to consume alcohol on Club property.
 2. No one who is, or appears to be, inebriated will be permitted in or around the barns, turn-out paddocks, or arenas.
 3. Reasonable social consumption of alcohol by riding members over the age of 19 will be permitted in the barn lounge areas.
 4. Absolutely no alcohol is permitted in the fitness center, on the tennis court, in the riding arenas, or anywhere outside on the property, including the parking lots.
- Wine lockers will be available to members for a fee

Membership Dues

Membership dues are payable on the first day of each month. Membership payments are due via pre authorized credit card payments or postdated cheques. High Point requires a minimum of 6 postdated cheques to start membership. There will be a \$25.00 charge for returned checks. Member who are on a credit card plan and miss more than 2 payments in a row are subject to a \$25.00 administration fee.

Membership dues are not refundable, nor are they prorated, except in the case of an occupied stall becoming unoccupied or vice versa.

A member must pay for any article of Club property damaged by a member or a member's guest or trainer

Cancellation

Members must provide 30 days' notice on the 1st of the month to cancel membership

Your cooperation in recognizing the importance of these rules and policies as well as adhering to them is greatly appreciated. The above rules are subject to change at the Board of Directors' discretion.
